The Non Pro Qualifiers will run concurrently with the NRBC Ancillary Non Pro classes. Class 60 will run concurrently with Class 115. Class 61 will run concurrently with class 215.

Entries must be entered in the Non Pro ancillary classes as well as pay this \$250 Qualifier fee per slate.

Pay \$250 fee per division, per slate to be eligible to qualify for The Run For A Million. Riders qualify only once and do not need to compete in the Championship on the horse that was used to qualify. To compete, riders must own or lease the horse based on NRHA rules. Remit payment with this form payable to the National Reining Breeders Classic (NRBC).

The Rookie Qualifiers will run concurrently with the NRBC Ancillary Rookie classes. Entries must be entered in the Rookie L2 or L1 ancillary classes, respectively, as well as pay the \$250 Qualifier Fee per slate and level.

The top five placings, and ties in each slate of Rookie and Non Pro classes that paid the qualifier fee will qualify to compete at The Run For A Million, August 14 – 17, 2024, Las Vegas, NV.
