Entries must be entered in the Non Pro ancillary classes as well as pay this \$250 Qualifier fee per slate.

Qualifier Fee per slate and level.

The top five placings, and ties in each slate of Rookie and Non Pro classes that paid the qualifier fee will qualify to compete at The Run For A Million, August 11 – 16, 2025, Las Vegas, NV.
