Divisions Definitions:

Junior Rider: Any person from the year in which they reach the age of 14 until the year in which they reach the age of 18 is allowed to take part in Junior Reining competitions.

Young Non Pro Rider: Any person having a NRHA Non Pro status from the year in which they reach the age of 18 until the year in which they reach the age of 25 is allowed to take part in reining competitions for Young Non Pro riders.

Senior Non Pro Rider: Any person who is a Non Pro rider (as defined by NRHA rules) and a person from the year in which they reach their 26th birthday is allowed to take part in Senior Non Pro rider competitions.

Prime Time Non Pro Rider: Any person who is a Non Pro rider (as defined by NRHA rules) and a person from the year in which they reach their 50th birthday is allowed to take part in Prime Time Non Pro rider competitions.

Young Professional Rider: Any person from the year in which they reach the age of 18 until the year in which they reach the age of 25 is allowed to take part in reining competitions for Young Professional riders.

Senior Professional Rider: Any person from the year in which they reach their 26th birthday is allowed to take part in Senior Professional rider competitions.
