The Field is Set National Reining Breeders Classic Open Finals

Kole Price had his horses dialed in during the preliminary round of the NRBC. The trainer from Pilot Point, Texas, qualified all three of his Level 4 Classic entries for the Finals and topped the Novice Horse division with another entry.

Price also tied to win the Open Level 4 preliminary round on two horses—Picture Perrfect and Golden Coins—who both also earned the top spot in the American Paint Horse Association Chrome Cash Incentive. Each horse picked up \$14,938 in earnings from the preliminary round alone.

The draw for the Finals will take place Thursday, April 24, at the Markel Insurance Open Finals Draw Party, scheduled for 3:30 p.m., immediately following a 3 p.m. press conference with the preliminary round winners. Both events are open to all attendees.

This year, the top 30 from the Open Level 4, Level 3, and Level 2 will earn a spot in the clean-slate finals, as will the top 27 in the Level 1 and the top 20 in the Open Prime Time. Competitors who qualify in Levels 3, 2, 1, or Prime Time will compete on Friday, April 25, while the Level 4 Finals will be held Saturday, April 26.

National Reining Breeders Classic

Ancillary Champions Crowned

Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 and Level 3 Champion - Alea Lasaponara & Never Dun Dreamn

From Campbell Hall, New York, Alea Lasaponara and Never Dun Dreamn will be bringing back a Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 and Level 3 Championship to the Northeast.

Marking a 71.5, Lasaponara and the 5-year-old stallion by Magnum Chic Dream and out of ARC Dun With Ya won over a thousand dollars between the two wins.

"I've had him for a little over a year now, and he's taught me so much. He's been really fun to show," Lasaponara said. Never Dun Dreamn is bred by Vicki Dias and owned by AML Reiners. While Lasaponara and the gelding's Derby Prelims earlier this week didn't go perfectly, they were able to smooth things over in Slate 2 of the Novice Horse Non Pro.

"My plan on my run today was to just go in and give him a good, confident ride. I showed him in the Derby Prelims, and we had a little bit of bobbles here and there, so I just wanted to go back and just give him a nice, confident ride."

The pair definitely picked up a boost of confidence with the win, but Lasaponara's confidence isn't only measured in wins; her team of people are her ultimate encouragers.

“I would like to thank my family, my team – especially Josiane (Gauthier). I wouldn’t be able to do any of this without her. Really, this is all God’s plan at the end of the day.”

Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 and Level 3 High Point Champion - Grace Tachikawa & Maggie Magnum

Although Grace Tachikawa and Maggie Magnum may have originally planned on taking a day off and keeping their names out of the draw sheet for Slate 2 of the Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 and Level 3, when the pieces fell into place just right for Central Park Hall Arena's slated pattern, sitting out didn't seem like the right choice.

"After the other day, I know I was like, 'Oh, I'll give her a break. I won't show her in the Novice Horse.' And then we saw it was pattern three, and I'm like, 'You know, that would be a good pattern to end the show on. It's totally different, and it gives us a chance to kind of school and just lope her through it, let her relax,'" Tachikawa said.

While she may have planned to use it as a no pressure schooling session, it came with its perks, as Tachikawa and Maggie Magnum ended up as the Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 and Level 3 High Point Champions with their score of a 71, as well as tying for second place in the Level 2 and 3.

"My plan was just to go do it and get a score, and that was it, and she was pretty honest... I just kind of pushed her through the bridle in my hand a few times, but she was there every step of the way. She's just that good. She's so steady."

The steady 9-year-old mare bred by Casey Hinton and owned by SRQ Performance Horses is by Magnum Chic Dream and out of Skeets Red Dunit. After that stellar performance, it seems Maggie Magnum didn't particularly care for a day off either – she'd much rather win buckles instead.



Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 and High Point Champion - Lindsey McCutcheon & Dreamy Lil Gun

Scoring a 71, Lindsey McCutcheon and Dreamy Lil Gun clean swept their level of the Novice Horse Non Pro, winning both the Level 1 and High Point championship.

"The mare I showed today, I've been showing for a few years now. We got her as a two-year-old actually, so (we've) had her for a while, and she's just been a consistent little ancillary horse for me. (I) show her in two slates everywhere we go, and she just keeps on trucking along. She's a pretty reliable horse," McCutcheon said.

Bred by Kathleen Roach and owned by Scott and Kathleen McCutcheon, the 6-year-old mare is by Magnum Chic Dream and out of Freckles Nu Lil Gun. "We knew when we saw her as a two-year-old that we wanted to give her a try," McCutcheon said. Giving Dreamy Lil Gun a try is a decision the McCutcheons are glad they made, especially considering the mare's ability to navigate trickier setups.

"This is kind of a tricky pattern, I think, for everybody. It's kind of a smaller arena to do the pattern in, so I think you got to be really, really specific about where you take your horse through the pattern in... She steered around really good for me. I don't think I've ever run this pattern on her before... She was with me, and it was fun."

Beyond her great horse, McCutcheon thanks her parents, everybody in her barn, and the entire NRBC staff for putting together a great show she loves to attend – and apparently win at.



Rookie Professional Champion - Garrett Lazaro & Tonite Tonite

Whether backing into a box or sliding into a stop, Garrett Lazaro knows how to win in either discipline. This time, his name was being called over a reining arena speaker.

Lazaro and Tonite Tonite, who is by Crystallized Gunner and out of Starrystarrynite, pulled off the Rookie Professional Championship in the Super Duty Arena, scoring a 73. Tonite Tonite is bred by Domingo Alvarado and owned by Skye Lazaro.

Lazaro's boss, Jarvis Anderson, showed the 4-year-old stallion at the NRHA Futurity last year and made the Level 2 Finals. Deciding Tonite Tonite would benefit from some more time in the show pen, Anderson sent Lazaro out on him for the Rookie Professional at the NRBC.

"I was very nervous going into it, mainly about the lead changes... But I knew he could circle pretty, stop huge and turn pretty, and I knew I could make up some points in that area," Lazaro said.

While Lazaro spends a lot of time on the back of a reiner, he also spends some time with a rope in hand. Success in both spaces holds merit, but winning in the reining pen measures slightly different because of the mental aspect of it.

"The reining pen feels more psychological but at the same time, the roping as well is very psychological. In reining, I feel like I go out there, and I get anxious about certain maneuvers, certain spots. I get nervous that my horse is going to look a certain way. In the roping pen, I get nervous for myself going out



there. It's a very mental game on both ends."

While the reining pen may personally put more pressure on himself from time to time, sometimes that added pressure is what is needed to secure a win, and that's what Lazaro did today.



NRBC Named No. 1 AQHA Alliance Event for 2024

The National Reining Breeders Classic (NRBC) has been recognized as the No. 1 ranked AQHA Alliance event for 2024 by the American Quarter Horse Association, topping the list of events across all disciplines.

The NRBC hosted two slates of AQHA classes in 2024, totaling 305 entries in Junior Reining, Senior Reining, Amateur Reining, Amateur Select Reining, and AQHA Youth 18 & Under.

"This recognition from the AQHA is something we're proud of," said NRBC President Tom McCutcheon. "We are glad to feature AQHA classes to benefit our owners and riders who are either trying to get qualified for the AQHA World Shows or to get points on their horses."

Open [1] Champion - Kaci O'Rourke & The Firemen

Kaci O'Rourke and The Firemen already pack an impressive resume. When they won the NRHA Level 3 and 4 Open Futurity at the tailend of 2024—a feat that hadn't yet been accomplished by a woman—the pair made history.

Here at the NRBC, they are adding to that resume by winning the Open Championship.

O'Rourke and the 4-year-old stallion, who is bred by Tamarack Ranch and owned by Peter and Courtney Morgan, scored a 75.5 to take the win. The Firemen, by Inferno Sixty Six and out of Redhot Walla, has already accumulated lifetime earnings surpassing \$400,000.

“Us and the owners elected not to show him here in the Classic just because we wanted to save him for the Derby and the 100x in the fall and just be really mindful of his longevity being that he's only a four-year-old. But I wanted to take the week to kind of prepare him and school him and just make sure he was ready for that next outing,” O'Rourke said.

O'Rourke is grateful to the Morgans for letting her train and show such a talented horse. “He felt incredible mentally. I had never even stepped foot in that pen before with him. So he's just so focused, and he's just such a good student. When we walked in, he was really quiet.”

A new pen doesn't mean added pressure – at least not for The Fireman. “I wanted to put my show clothes on and just see how he was going to feel with a little bit of pressure, and I just took him in nice and easy, and I mean he was absolutely



fantastic,” O'Rourke said.

O'Rourke has never doubted the stallion for even a second, but pulling an Open win like this was just the thing the team needed to springboard their mission of keeping their names in the history books.

Non Pro Champion - Kathleen Armenta & Off N Running

With over 20 years of NRBC experience, Kathleen Armenta knows how to win, especially when the color blue fills the arena.

Aboard Off N Running, a 10-year-old gelding by Walla Walla Whiz and out of Spook Off Sparks, Armenta won the Non Pro Championship with a score of 73. Off N Running is bred by Arcese Quarter Horses and owned by Armenta Quarter Horses.

Their spins weren't the only thing that was speedy – their trip to the arena was also quick.

"The class before us went really fast, so we had a timeline, and then the timeline got shortened up, and we were kind of in a hurry. So we warmed up really fast, and then we headed over to the Central Park Arena, and we had about five horses to go," Armenta said.

Rushed or not, Armenta knows her way around the Expo Square.

"I've been coming to the NRBC for 20 some years, since it was in Katy, Texas. We loved it in Katy, but this

is so much bigger and so much and greater now being in Tulsa."

When asked who she'd like to thank, Armenta said, "Everybody here at the barn – Casey Hinton, Kathy Hinton, Bill, Nancy, my co-Non Pro in the barn, (and) Steve Brownlee who's our former Non Pro in the barn."

With many years in the reining industry, it's clear to see Armenta has acquired quite the support system, as well as NRBC success.

Intermediate Open & Limited Open Champion - Naike Bell & Boujee

Naike Bell and Boujee snuck onto the leaderboard in the Super Duty Arena to win both the Intermediate Open and Limited Open Championship.

Scoring a 75, the duo will be cashing in over a grand for the combined total of the wins.

Boujee is by Magnum Chic Dream and out of Chexanicki. The 8-year-old mare is bred by Alpha Quarter Horses and owned by Thorsport.

In the grand scheme of things, Bell has only been piloting Boujee for a short time, spending the bulk of the winter getting to know the mare – and it clearly paid off. "My favorite part was definitely the stop... She stopped huge. And I got the roll back to go with it, so that was pretty snappy, and it was fun," Bell said.

While Bell has never competed in the Derby, an Ancillary class is one she is accustomed to at the NRBC – her familiarity with a two slated class evident in her double-title win.

Bell is quick to thank the people who have helped her and Boujee excel at this level. "(I thank) Allison Thorson that owns the mare and my husband Brian Bell that is always behind me – he got me a good horse to show."

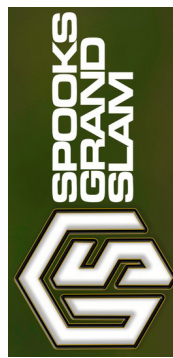

“I’ve had him for right about a year now. In the last few months, we’ve definitely had a lot of improvements. Today I was kind of planning on just cruising him through, but he ended up being really good for me and managed to get me a good score to win,” Williams said.

Williams didn’t put much pressure on the gelding and figured she’d see where the cards fall when it’s all said and done – and they landed just right, as the team turned in a smooth run deserving of a title.

“So he started out with his stops, (which) were beautiful... His circles were phenomenal. He just put his head down and ran for me, slowed down like an angel, as always. And then ended off with

some of his best spins that we’ve had in the show pen for sure,” Williams said.

Having their smoothest spins yet at the NRBC is a great place for personal bests, but the team didn’t get here alone. “(I thank) both my parents, of course, for supporting me through all of us... My trainer Clint Ramsey, for always being there and being super, super helpful through all of it,” Williams said.

As a youth contender, Williams feels fortunate to have parents and a trainer who strive to make sure her dreams—such as winning a Non Pro Intermediate Championship—are always within reach.

Classic Connection- Will Davidson

While he may be classified as a Short Stirrup competitor, 10-year-old Will Davidson's list of ambitions is anything but short.

Coming off a streak of Short Stirrup wins, Will is looking to get even more titles under his belt coming into this year's NRBC aboard horse What The Fuzz. So far in 2025, the pair has placed in five classes, recently winning the Youth 10 & Under Short Stirrup at the The Spring Fling show and placing third in both slates of the Short Stirrup at the Oklahoma Ride & Slide.

Will and What The Fuzz are a fairly new team in the arena, as the Davidsons purchased the 7-year-old gelding from Cade McCutcheon this past fall. Known as "Fuzz" around the barn, he is by Spooks Gotta Whiz and out of Gotta Git Ya Dun.

Thanks to trainer Nathan Piper, the Davidsons were able to find Fuzz.

"We're very fortunate. Nathan helped us find Fuzz," Casey Davidson, Will's mom, said. Through riding with Piper, Will has been able to make leaps and bounds in the saddle, making the long commute to ride with the successful trainer well worth it.

"We keep our horses at home in Nacogdoches – it's very deep East Texas. So when we go to ride with Nathan, we drive about four and a half hours. We maintain Will's horse at home, but Nathan can also kind of tune on him a little bit at the show," Casey said.

While Casey has competed at the NRBC in past years, this week she is just "momming it" and running Will and daughter Deanna (who's competing in the Non Pro this week) between arenas.

Will plans to compete in the Short Stirrup on Friday in the Central Park Hall arena. Having already marked several upper 60 scores—more recently receiving a 72 in a warm up class—aboard Fuzz in their short time together thus far, the youth rider has some big goals in mind. When asked about his goals in the Texas Reining Horse Association specifically, Will said, "To get first in the All-Around and win a saddle and buckle."

Casey is grateful that the industry places an emphasis and focus on its youth competitors. "It's kind of a big deal for Short Stirrups to win a saddle. We're excited about that. He's been working really hard," Casey said.

Will might only have a couple years worth of reining experience, but those handful of years have brought some success – success the young cowboy is thankful for. "(I would like to thank) my dad, for getting me to show, Mr. Nathan for coaching me, my friends, and then I have to thank my mom – she does all the show shirts," Will said.

With such a committed support system and work ethic, a champion Short Stirrup buckle and saddle very possibly may be the next goal the team can check off their list.

Novice Horse Open & Chrome Cash Champion - Kole Price

Kole Price is making his mark on the 2025 NRBC, and he's doing it with a stacked string of horses. A triple threat on arena dirt, he piloted three into the Ford Arena's winner's circle to earn a Novice Horse Open and Chrome Cash Championship.

Scoring a 220.5, Price and Thee Price Is Right secured the win in the Novice Horse Open. Thee Price Is Right is by Spooks Gotta Whiz and out of Ruf Style Of Play. The 4-year-old gelding is bred by Axel Bouchner and owned by Toni Dunker. Thee Price Is Right also placed fifth in the Open Chrome Cash.

Thee Price Is Right was not one of Price's allotted three for the Open Level 4 Classic.

"The Price is Right, I showed him actually (on) Monday... I was very, very happy with him. The reason we decided to just show him in the Novice is to just kind of season him a little bit... I thought this would be a good way for me to make a run and keep seasoning him without putting all the extra pressure on him, and he showed perfect. He was exactly mentally where I wanted him to be," Price said.

Along with a Novice Horse Open title, Price also claimed the Chrome Cash Championship aboard two horses – scoring a 224 on Picture Perrfect, then stepping into the ring the following Wednesday morning with Golden Coins to match it.

"Picture Perrfect, I showed him yesterday (Tuesday), he was a 224. He was awesome. He really stopped big. Circled huge like he does... He was super easy to show. I was super happy with him."

Picture Perrfect is bred by Amy Medows and owned by Ronald Anderson. The 4-year-old stallion, who is by Spooks Gotta Whiz and out of Isnt She Perfect, has already acquired \$173,701 in lifetime earnings.

Golden Coins— also a stallion—is bred by Silver Spurs Equine and owned by Coin Toss. The 5-year-old is by Spooks Gotta Gun and out of Electric Cha Ching.

"This morning (Wednesday), on Golden Coins, I was a 224 with him as well. He showed like an absolute machine out there. He was super confident. Electric but super quiet. So I was tickled with both of those horses, and (I'm) super excited for the finals."

With the two titles on three horses, Price will be pocketing \$15,665. While Price credits the horses he sat on for that payday, he also thanks his wife, Kelsey Price.

"I'm going to thank my wife because she's been very tough on me with practicing and schooling and... holding myself accountable, being correct. We're big believers that confidence comes from the preparation that you do at home, so I'm going to give all the credit to my wife."

Beyond Thee Price Is Right, Picture Perrfect, and Golden Coins, Price also piloted Scottie Doesnt Know to a fourth-place finish in the Open Chrome Cash with a score of 221, earning \$886. The three horses Price will be advancing to the Saturday finals on are Picture Perrfect, Golden Coins, and Scottie Doesnt Know – and he may just be going for a three-for-three once more.

Classic Connection

Alea Lasaponara

From the beginning, Alea Lasaponara had the bright lights of the Olympics in her sights. Starting at the age of two at a local lesson barn, Lasaponara's feet sat in irons and her hands held reins that were close-looped.

"My goal had been to go to the Olympics and be a big equitation rider. My parents told me if I wanted to do that, I had to go work for it. So I put in the hours at the barn – I helped with stalls, turnout, the whole nine yards. Eventually, they started letting me take lessons with some big name hunter jumper riders, which was the best thing in the world to me at the time," Lasaponara said.

Lasaponara gained invaluable experience working beneath those top-notch riders and decided maybe her interest fell more in the scope of jumping than equitation. With that switch, she began

riding with BJ Ehrhardt, a Grand Prix level equestrian, and Peter Leone, a show jumping Olympian. Yet, Lasaponara's course would change when her dad decided to bring home a horse of a completely different discipline.

"On the way home from a show, my dad told me he had bought a reining horse. And I was like, 'What's a reining horse, dad?' At first, I didn't know what reining was, but eventually I got hooked."

It took one show outing on the horse Lasaponara's dad brought home for her to trade in breeches for a pair of chaps.

"I've officially been reining for three years now, and I've been with Josiane (Gauthier)—who I'm very grateful for, and I couldn't be doing any of this without—for a year now," Lasaponara said.

Transitioning to a completely different discipline has certainly come with its own set of variations for Lasaponara.

"I do think that my mentality going into showing in the English was different... If you miss a distance to a jump, you and your horse can get seriously hurt. Riding reiners, I think it's helped me and my headspace a lot more. If you miss a stop, it's okay. There's always another show."

"I also think that riding English gave me a really strong foundation for reining. There were a few things, like your hand position, but overall, I feel like I did pick it up fairly naturally," Lasaponara said.

Although still new to the industry in the grand scheme of things, for the last two years (this year behind her third) Lasaponara has attended the NRBC, she has made a Finals. She also has racked up nearly \$94,000 in lifetime earnings already as a Non Pro.

Although her most current success has been on the back of reiner, Lasaponara thanks all of the trainers she's crossed paths with – no matter the type of saddle they had her in.

"All of my trainers since I was two years old to now, English or reining, they've all helped me get here."
